

Copy editing: checking for clarity, coherence, flow and fluency, correctness of grammar and punctuation, appropriate language, correct style, referencing or attribution and general accuracy.

Proofreading: Checking for and correcting errors such as spelling, punctuation and syntax.

At present, I don't advise on PhD theses or academic journal articles for specific journals.
